

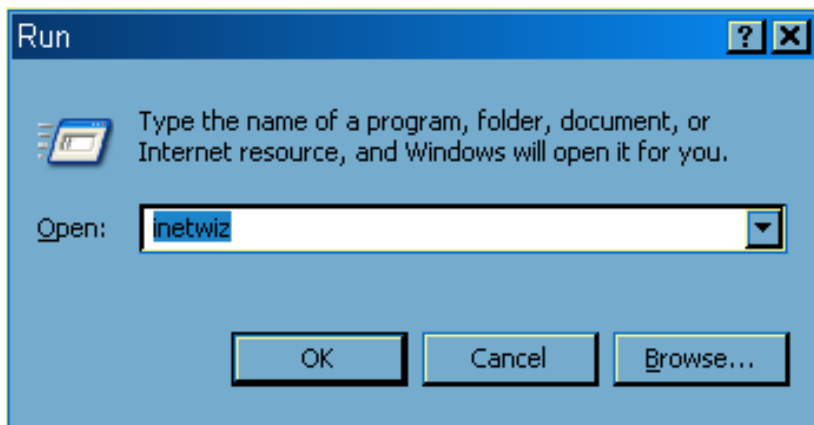


## NETECTION SETUP SHEET

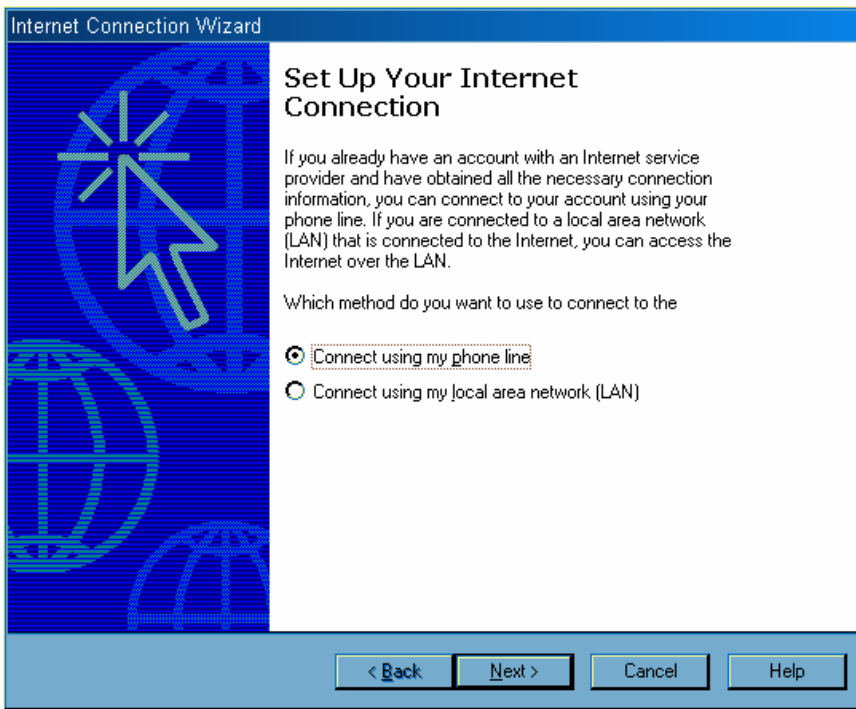
Click on Start

On the screen that opens (Set up Your Internet Connection) select the option Connect Using My Phone Line

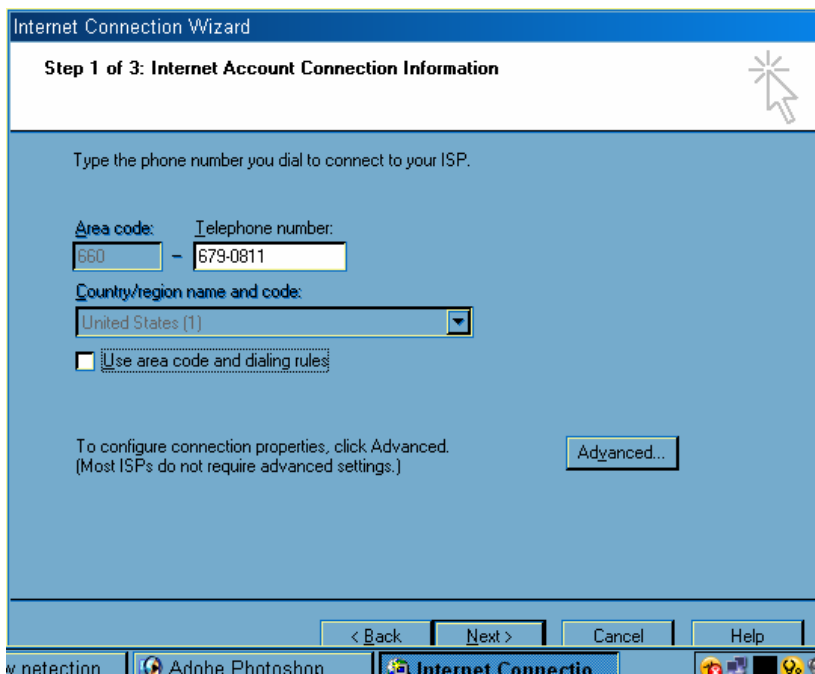


*Click Next*

**Uncheck** the box (Make sure the box is blank) Use Area Code and Dialing Properties



Type in your username and password









When you send e-mail, your name will appear in the From field of the outgoing message. Type your name as you would like it to appear.






The Incoming Mail Server is a **POP3** Server. (Should be the default)


It will ask for your Account Name which is your full email address and for your Password which must be 8 characters minimum and is case sensitive. Enter them and make sure that the check box that says Remember Password is checked.
